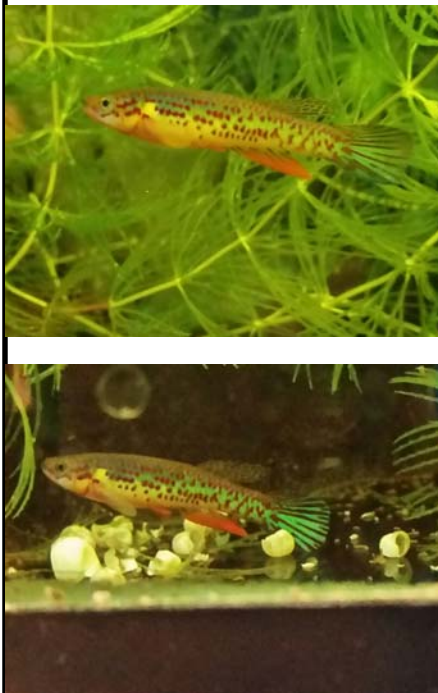

Roland Wendel was born in 1960 in the town of Muehlen in the Black Forest region of southern Germany. He is married to Christa, his wife of over 20 years, and has a daughter and son. He had recently moved to Lueneburger Heide in northern Germany. Roland has kept fish since his youth and got started with killifish in 1974 after seeing them in a fish show. His interests are the killifish of Gabon, especially those from the Diapteron and Lampeyes groups. He also maintains a healthy interest in the killifish of the temperate zones, primarily Fundulus and Aphanis. Roland has maintained Fundulus julisia for many years and is responsible for its wide distribution within Europe. Roland was collected in Gabon twice, first in 1986 (GWW 86) and more recently in 2013. His talk will cover those two trips and what changes he has observed. His talk "Operation Hylo or Gabon 27 years later" will discuss those collecting spots as well as how he keeps those species.
